Introduction

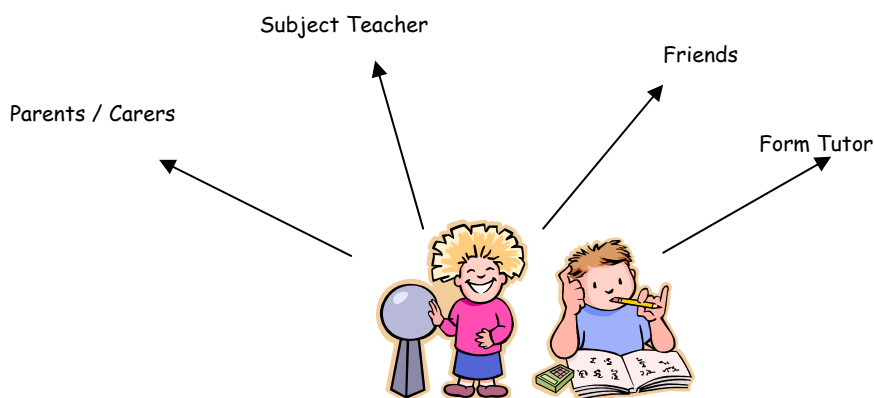
- Throughout the course of the year you will be set an extended learning project for each of the subjects that you study.
- Each Project will last for either 2 or 3 weeks and should take you 10 - 15 hours to complete.
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NB In addition to your project work you will be set weekly English, Maths and Science homework connected to the work that you do in class and from time to time other subjects might set you homework also. This work is different to your project work and there is a section in the back of your folder to store this work.

The Aims of the Projects

- The projects aim to get you developing your Personal Learning & Thinking Skills or your PLTS. These are
 - independent enquiry
 - creative thinking
 - reflective learning
 - team work
 - self-managing
 - effective participation
- The projects aim to introduce you to topics, related to subjects that you study in school, in a more interesting way.
